**Virginia Launches Central Pre-Registration Website for COVID-19 Vaccine**

- Statewide hotline launched Wednesday, 2/17/21
- **Call: (877) VAX-IN-VA, or (877) 829-4682, from 8am – 8pm, Monday – Friday.**
- **PWHD Call Center** will continue to answer COVID-19 test result questions and assisting with COVID-19 vaccine scheduling, **however, all appointments will be booked from the new Virginia pre-registration system.**
- **PWHD Call Center hours are 7 days a week from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.**

## **New VA Vaccination Site – Manassas Mall! (2/16/21)**

**New COVID vaccination site opened:** Tuesday, February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

The new PWHHD COVID vaccination site at Manassas Mall will open at the:

- **Manassas Mall at 8300 Sudley Road Manassas, VA, 20109;** next to the Autobahn store.
- This location provides a larger space for an increased ability for vaccine distribution.
- Due to this change, **GMU Beacon Hall and Kelley Leadership Clinic are closed** since it does not allow for further expansion as vaccine allocations increase.
- By opening the Manassas Mall location, vaccination stations will increase by 20 to 30 stations.

## **PHARMACY VACCINATORS – 51 TOTAL**

CVS Health has been identified by the federal government as a primary vaccination partner in 11 states, including Maryland and Virginia (confirmed).

### **Giant Food locations**

There are 12 Giant pharmacies vaccinating people, with locations in the Baltimore area, the Washington, D.C., suburbs and Southern Maryland.

- Sign up for an appointment by clicking “Schedule An Appointment Here”: <https://giantfood.com/pages/covid-info>.

- Your identification will be checked at the time of your appointment to ensure you are eligible.

### **Martin's locations**

Martin's supermarkets are reportedly vaccinating people at locations in Allegany and Washington counties.

- Sign up for vaccine (only if eligible) by visiting <https://martinssched.rxtouch.com/rbssched/program/covid19/Patient/Advisory>.

### **Rite Aid locations**

Five locations administering vaccines in Baltimore City and Baltimore and Somerset counties.

- Sign up for your first shot by going to <https://www.riteaid.com/pharmacy/covid-qualifier>
- Fill out the qualification form, which will determine if you are eligible.

### **Safeway locations**

Eleven Safeway pharmacies are offering the coronavirus vaccine in Baltimore, Charles, Montgomery, Prince George's and Queen Anne's counties.

### **Sam's Club**

Sam's Club, which is owned by Walmart, says it's vaccinating only those eligible under Maryland guidelines.

- It's unclear how Sam's Club is screening patients.

Participating in vaccine distribution but must register a profile online. Will take you through 4 questions to determine eligibility.

Ten Walmart stores are vaccinating people in Maryland, with locations in Caroline, Cecil, Dorchester, Garrett, Talbot, Wicomico, Worcester counties.
